**ANAC RULE REMINDER**

Even though we dropped the size  
restrictions for our local Spring Show  
and the qualifying ANAC portion  
of the show, the qualifying pieces  
for ANAC may NOT be any larger  
than 40"x40" framed, and no more  
than 75 lbs. If your piece qualifies  
for ANAC and has glass on it, please  
replace it with plexi-glass. ONLY  
pastel art pieces may have glass.

**LAG SHOW SALES INFO**

The artist collects the money, sends  
the LAG 20% donation into LAG and

turns the sales tax into the state.  
The artist will be contacted when  
a patron inquires about any piece  
shown in a LAG show. You will be  
given the contact information of the  
patron. You are then responsible for  
connecting with the patron for the  
sale. Then you need to collect the  
money, including sales tax of 7%.  
The patron makes the check out to  
you, the artist. The 20% donation  
portion of the sell needs to be made  
out to LAG & sent to Jan Spale,  
LAG Treasurer, 5240 Wilshire Blvd.,  
Lincoln, NE 68504 (464-1226).

You are on your honor. The guild  
functions on "teamwork, honesty and  
loyalty." A list will be kept of possible  
LAG sales and contacts. With juried  
shows, the sold piece must remain in

the show until the end of the show.  
ANAC qualifying pieces may not be  
picked up by the buyer until after  
the ANAC conference. If the piece  
is chosen for the ANAC travel show,  
the buyer would need to know it will  
be a year until they may receive the  
purchased piece.
